
MAX STREICHER GmbH & Co. KG aA – in a joint venture with two French companies – is responsible for the execution of a 56 km pipeline (DN 400) in Brittany/France. STREICHER takes over the technical management of the project.

The scope of the order includes all civil engineering and pipeline works, various crossings using different methods and the installation of a transfer station.

The acceptance of the pipeline is planned for spring 2022.

The project's aim is to supply natural gas to the combined cycle power plant in Landivisiau, currently being built by Direct Energie (TOTAL). In addition, the project is of great importance for industrial consumers and households in the Brest region, since the additional transport capacities can significantly increase the security of supply in southern Brittany.
